The Oregon Medical Board (Board) is the state agency responsible for licensing, regulating and disciplining certain health care providers, including physicians, in the State of Oregon. Frank Albert Sievert, MD (Licensee) is a licensed physician in the State of Oregon.

2.

On June 23, 2023, the Board opened an investigation after receiving credible information regarding Licensee’s possible violation of the Medical Practice Act, specifically his ability to safely and competently practice medicine due to inaccurate diagnoses and inappropriate treatments which delay appropriate medical care. On December 9, 2024, the Board issued an Order for Evaluation requiring Licensee to obtain an assessment from the Center for Personalized Education for Professionals. Licensee has declined to obtain this evaluation.

3.

Licensee and the Board desire to settle this matter by the entry of this Stipulated Order. Licensee understands that he has the right to a contested case hearing under the Administrative Procedures Act (Oregon Revised Statutes chapter 183) and, by the signing and issuance of this Order, Licensee fully and finally waives the right to a contested case hearing, understands and acknowledges that this order is not subject to judicial review, and acknowledges and agrees that this Order was signed freely, without fraud or duress. Licensee neither admits nor denies, but the Board finds that Licensee engaged in conduct that violated the Medical Practice Act, to wit: ORS 677.190(17) willful violation of a board order, specifically an Order issued under ORS

1 677.420. Licensee understands that this Order is a public record and is a disciplinary action that
2 is reportable to the National Practitioner Data Bank and the Federation of State Medical Boards.

3 4.

4 Licensee and the Board agree that the Board will close this investigation and resolve this
5 matter by entry of this Stipulated Order, subject to the following conditions:

6 4.1 Licensee surrenders his Oregon medical license while under investigation.

7 4.2 Licensee must not reapply for a medical license in the State of Oregon for at least
8 two years from the effective date of this Order.

9 4.3 If Licensee reapplies for an Oregon medical license, he will be asked to
10 demonstrate clinical competency prior to a license being granted.


11 4.4 Licensee must obey all federal and Oregon state laws and regulations pertaining
12 to the practice of medicine.

13 4.5 Licensee stipulates and agrees that any violation of the terms of this Order shall
14 be grounds for further disciplinary action under ORS 677.190(17).

16 This Order becomes effective the date it is signed by the Board Chair.
