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4.

At the conclusion of the Board's investigation, the limitation placed on Licensee will be reviewed in an expeditious manner. If the Board determines, following that review, that these limitations shall not be lifted, Licensee may request a hearing to contest that decision.

5.

This order is issued by the Board pursuant to ORS 677.265 while the Board conducts its investigation for the purpose of fully informing itself with respect to the performance or conduct of the Licensee and Licensee's ability to safely and competently practice acupuncture. Pursuant to ORS 677.425, Board investigative materials are confidential and shall not be subject to public disclosure, nor shall they be admissible as evidence in any judicial proceeding. However, as a stipulation this Order is a public document, and is reportable to the National Databank and the Federation of State Medical Boards.
