The Oregon Medical Board (Board) is the state agency responsible for licensing, regulating, and disciplining physicians and the practice of medicine in Oregon. Frank Albert Sievert, MD (Licensee) is a licensed physician in the State of Oregon.

2.

The Board initiated an investigation based on allegations that Licensee was negligent in providing medical care for the prevention and treatment of COVID-19. As a result of the Board's investigation, the Board issued a Notice of Proposed Disciplinary Action (Notice) on October 5, 2023, in which the Board proposed taking disciplinary action by imposing up to the maximum range of potential sanctions identified in ORS 677.205(2) for alleged violations of the Medical Practice Act, specifically, ORS 677.190(1)(a) as defined by ORS 677.188(4)(a) and ORS 677.188(4)(c); ORS 677.190(9); and ORS 677.190(13).

3.

Licensee and the Board desire to settle this matter by entry of this Agreement pursuant to ORS 677.410. Licensee understands that he has the right to a contested case hearing under the Administrative Procedures Act (Oregon Revised Statutes chapter 183). Licensee fully and finally waives the right to a contested case hearing and any appeal therefrom by the signing and entry of this Agreement in the Board's records. Licensee understands that this Agreement is a public record and is reportable to the National Practitioner Data Bank and the Federation of State Medical Boards; however, it is a non-disciplinary action. Licensee understands the terms of this Agreement and signs freely, without fraud or duress. The Board agrees to resolve the current

1 investigation with this Agreement and does not make a finding in regard to any violation of the
2 Medical Practice Act.

4 In this Agreement, Licensee and the Board agree to the following terms and conditions:

5 4.1 Within three months from the effective date of this Agreement, Licensee agrees to
6 successfully complete a toxicology course that has been pre-approved by the Board's Medical
7 Director.

8 4.2 Within three months from the effective date of this Agreement, Licensee agrees to
9 successfully complete a course in evidence-based medicine that has been pre-approved by the
10 Board's Medical Director.

11 4.3 Prior to providing care to any Oregon patient for the prevention and treatment of
12 COVID-19, Licensee agrees, at his own expense, to enter into an agreement with a licensed,
13 board-certified primary care physician (MD or DO) who is pre-approved by the Board's Medical
14 Director to serve as Licensee's mentor in the provision of care for the prevention and treatment
15 of COVID-19. The mentor must review patient charts within one week of Licensee's providing
16 medical care to the patient(s) for the prevention or treatment of COVID-19. The mentor must
17 provide quarterly written reports to the Board regarding Licensee's ability to safely and
18 competently provide care related to COVID-19.

19 4.4 Licensee agrees to obey all federal and Oregon state laws and regulations
20 pertaining to the practice of medicine.

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1 4.5 Licensee agrees that any violation of the terms of this Agreement constitutes
2 grounds to take disciplinary action under ORS 677.190(17).
