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9 The Oregon Medical Board (Board) is the state agency responsible for licensing,
10 regulating and disciplining certain health care providers, including physicians, in the State of
11 Oregon. Cory Todd Johnson, MD (Licensee) is a licensed physician in the State of Oregon.

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13 On December 3, 2020, Licensee entered into an Interim Stipulated Order with the Board
14 in which he agreed to voluntarily withdraw from practice and place his license in Inactive status
15 pending the completion of the Board's investigation. On June 17, 2021, the Board issued an
16 Second Amended Complaint and Notice of Proposed Disciplinary Action in which the Board
17 proposed to take disciplinary action pursuant to ORS 677.205(2), which may include the
18 revocation of license, a \$10,000 civil penalty and assessment of costs, against Licensee for
19 violating the Medical Practice Act, to wit: ORS 677.190(1)(a) unprofessional or dishonorable
20 conduct, as defined in ORS 677.188 conduct unbecoming a person licensed to practice medicine
21 or detrimental to the best interest of the public as further defined in OAR 847-010-0073(3)(b)(G)
22 sexual misconduct, ORS 677.188(4)(a) any conduct or practice contrary to recognized standards
23 of ethics of the medical profession or any conduct or practice which does or might constitute a
24 danger to the health or safety of a patient or the public; and ORS 677.190(13) gross or repeated
25 acts of negligence.

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2 Licensee and the Board desire to settle this matter by the entry of this Stipulated Order.
3 Licensee understands that he has the right to a contested case hearing under the Administrative
4 Procedures Act (Oregon Revised Statutes chapter 183), and fully and finally waives the right to a
5 contested case hearing and any appeal therefrom by the signing of and entry of this Order in the
6 Board's records. Licensee admits that he engaged in conduct as described in the June 17, 2021,
7 Second Amended Complaint and Notice of Proposed Disciplinary Action, and that this conduct
8 violated the Medical Practice Act, to wit ORS 677.190(1)(a), as defined in ORS 677.188, OAR
9 847-010-0073(3)(b)(G), and ORS 677.188(4)(a); and ORS 677.190(13). Licensee understands
10 that this Order is a public record and is a disciplinary action that is reportable to the National
11 Practitioner Data Bank and the Federation of State Medical Boards. Licensee understands the
12 terms of this Order and signs freely, without fraud or duress.

14 Licensee and the Board agree that the Board will close this investigation and resolve this
15 matter by entry of this Stipulated Order, subject to the following conditions:

16 4.1 Licensee's Oregon medical license is revoked.

17 4.2 The Interim Stipulated Order of December 3, 2020, terminates effective the date
18 the Board Chair signs this Stipulated Order.

19 4.3 Licensee must not reapply for a medical license in the State of Oregon for at least
20 two years from the effective date of this Order

21 4.4 Licensee must obey all federal and Oregon state laws and regulations pertaining
22 to the practice of medicine.

23 4.5 Licensee stipulates and agrees that any violation of the terms of this Order shall
24 be grounds for further disciplinary action under ORS 677.190(17).

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This Order becomes effective the date it is signed by the Board Chair.
