The Board of Medical Examiners (Board) is the state agency responsible for licensing, regulating and disciplining certain health care providers in the State of Oregon. Steven Mark Rotter, M.D. (Licensee) is a licensed physician in the State of Oregon.

In November of 1995, the Board became aware that Licensee was under investigation by the Portland Police Bureau for possession, manufacturing and distribution of marijuana. As a result of the criminal investigation Licensee was suspended by his employer. On December 13, 1996, Licensee plead guilty to manufacturing of a controlled substance, a Class A felony.

Licensee stipulates that he engaged in the conduct described above in paragraph 2 and that this conduct violates ORS 677.190(1)(a) unprofessional or dishonorable conduct as defined in ORS 677.188(4)(a), ORS 677.190(6) conviction of an

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1 offense punishable by incarceration, and ORS 677.190(24) violation
2 of Federal Controlled Substances Act. Licensee further stipulates
3 that such conduct constitutes grounds for discipline pursuant to
4 ORS 677.205.

6 Licensee and the Board agree that this disciplinary
7 investigation may be concluded by entry of this order of
8 revocation, which revocation shall be stayed pending compliance
9 with the following conditions:

10 4.1 Licensee shall pay a \$5,000 civil penalty within six
11 months of the date of this order.

12 4.2 Licensee shall successfully complete a five-year
13 probation supervised by the Board's Compliance Officer. The
14 probation terms consist of the following:

- 15 a. Licensee will continue to receive treatment with a
16 mental health professional who has been approved by the
17 Board's Investigative Committee.
- 18 b. Licensee shall submit to random urinalysis with an
19 independent laboratory, the results of which shall be
20 provided to the Board's compliance officer. This
21 probationary urinalysis shall be conducted at Licensee's
22 expense.

21 Evidence of violation of the terms of this order shall be
22 grounds for implementation of an order of revocation in this
23 matter and shall be grounds for further disciplinary action
24 pursuant to ORS 677.205.

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6.

Licensee and the Board understand that by resolving this matter through stipulation, Licensee waives his right to a contested case hearing under the Oregon Administrative Procedures Act, or to any appeal therefrom.
