The Board of Medical Examiners (Board) is the state agency responsible for licensing, regulating and disciplining certain health care providers, including physicians, in the State of Oregon. Susan Jacqueline Logan, MD (Licensee) is a licensed physician in the State of Oregon.

2.

The Board proposed taking disciplinary action pursuant to ORS 677.205 against Licensee for violations of the Medical Practice Act, to wit: ORS 677.190(1)(a) unprofessional or dishonorable conduct, as defined in ORS 677.188(4)(a); ORS 677.190(7) habitual or excessive use of intoxicants; ORS 677.190(18), willfully violating a Board order; and ORS 677.190(25), prescribing controlled substances without a legitimate medical purpose.

3.

Licensee's history includes abusing prescription opiates in 1997. Licensee entered the Board's Health Professionals Program (HPP) in 1999 for chemical dependency, which required her to remain abstinent from alcohol and controlled substances, sedatives, tranquilizers and all mind-altering or potentially addictive drugs. Licensee also surrendered her DEA number so that she could no longer write prescriptions for controlled substances. After undergoing inpatient treatment, Licensee resumed practicing medicine in June of 2000. Based upon its investigation, the Board concludes that Licensee engaged in the following conduct:

3.1 Late in 2000, Licensee began using gabapentin (Neurontin) for the euphoric state it induced. Licensee took between 2400 and 3600 mgs twice a day of Neurontin for an extended period of time. Licensee obtained this medication by creating fictitious patient charts and
