

Stipulated Order with the Board in which he agreed to voluntarily withdraw from practice and place his license in Inactive status pending the completion of the Board's investigation into his ability to safely and competently practice medicine.

2.5 On October 17, 2025, Licensee submitted a “no contest” plea to one count of sexual abuse by fraudulent representation, one count of sexual abuse in the 2nd degree, and one count of sexual abuse in the 3rd degree. On October 24, 2025, a hearing was held in Washington County Circuit Court, and Licensee was convicted of the above counts and sentenced to three years of supervised probation and prohibition from working in the medical field.

Licensee and the Board desire to settle this matter by entry of this Stipulated Order which is a final order of the Board. Licensee understands that he has the right to a contested case hearing under the Administrative Procedures Act (Oregon Revised Statutes chapter 183) and, by the signing and issuance of this Order, Licensee fully and finally waives the right to a contested case hearing, understands and acknowledges that this order is not subject to judicial review, and acknowledges and agrees that this Order was signed freely, without fraud or duress. Licensee neither admits nor denies, but the Board finds that Licensee engaged in conduct that violated the Medical Practice Act, to wit: ORS 677.190(1)(a) unprofessional or dishonorable conduct, as conduct unbecoming a person licensed to practice medicine or detrimental to the best interest of the public, specifically ORS 677.188(4)(a) any conduct or practice contrary to recognized standards of ethics of the medical profession, ORS 677.188(4)(a) conduct which does or might constitute a danger to health or safety of a patient, and OAR 847-010-0073(3)(b)(F) sexual misconduct; ORS 677.190(13) repeated negligence in the practice of medicine; ORS 677.190(13) gross negligence in the practice of medicine; and 677.190(6) conviction of any offense punishable by incarceration. Licensee understands that this Order is a public record and is a disciplinary action that is reportable to the National Practitioner Data Bank and the Federation of State Medical Boards.

2 Licensee and the Board agree that the Board will close this investigation and resolve this
3 matter by entry of this Stipulated Order, subject to the following conditions:

4 4.1 Licensee's Oregon medical license is revoked.

5 4.2 Licensee must not reapply for a physician associate license in the State of Oregon
6 for at least two years from the effective date of this Order. If Licensee reapplies for a physician
7 associate license in the State of Oregon, he will be required to demonstrate qualifications under
8 ORS 677.100 and medical competency.

9 4.3 Licensee is assessed a civil penalty of \$10,000; this civil penalty is held in
10 abeyance so long as Licensee does not reapply for a Licensee in Oregon and is in compliance
11 with all other terms and conditions of this Order. If Licensee fails to comply with the terms of
12 this Order or applies for an Oregon license, the \$10,000 held in abeyance shall be due and
13 payable.

14 4.4 The November 2, 2023, Interim Stipulated Order terminates upon the effective
15 date of this Stipulated Order.

16 4.5 Within 10 days of the change of Licensee's license status to revoked, Licensee
17 must notify the Oregon Medical Board as to how patients may access or obtain their medical
18 records, pursuant to OAR 847-012-0000.

19 4.6 Licensee must obey all federal and Oregon state laws and regulations pertaining
20 to the practice of medicine.

21 4.7 Licensee stipulates and agrees that any violation of the terms of this Order shall
22 be grounds for further disciplinary action under ORS 677.190(17).

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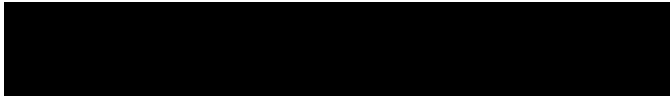
