The Oregon Medical Board (Board) is the state agency responsible for licensing, regulating and disciplining certain health care providers, including physicians, in the State of Oregon. Thomas Philip McWeeney, MD (Licensee) is a licensed physician in the State of Oregon.

2.

2.1 On January 7, 2016, Licensee entered into a Stipulated Order with the Board that closed a Board investigation. In this Order, the Board concluded that Licensee had engaged in conduct that constituted unprofessional or dishonorable conduct as well as gross or repeated acts of negligence. The Order imposed terms and conditions on Licensee's surgical practice and required Licensee to complete courses which had been pre-approved by the Board.

2.2 On February 25, 2021, the Board issued an Amended Complaint and Notice of Proposed Disciplinary Action (Notice) in which the Board proposed to take disciplinary action by imposing up to the maximum range of potential sanctions identified in ORS 677.205(2), which may include the revocation of license, a \$10,000 civil penalty, and assessment of costs, against Licensee for violations of the Medical Practice Act, to wit: ORS 677.190(1)(a) unprofessional or dishonorable conduct, as defined in ORS 677.188(4)(a) and (b); ORS 677.190(8) fraud or misrepresentation in applying for or procuring a license to practice in this state, as defined in ORS 677.188(1); ORS 677.190(13) repeated negligence in the practice of medicine; ORS 677.190(17) violation of a Board order; and ORS 677.190(26) failure to report to

1 the Board any adverse action taken against Licensee by a health care institution or professional
2 or medical society or association for acts or conduct similar to acts or conduct that would
3 constitute grounds for disciplinary described in the Medical Practice Act, including ORS
4 677.190(14) incapacity or incompetence. Licensee responded to the Board's Amended
5 Complaint and Notice of Proposed Disciplinary Action by denying the allegations and requesting
6 a hearing.

8 Licensee and the Board desire to settle this matter by entry of this Stipulated Order.
9 Licensee understands that he has the right to a contested case hearing under the Administrative
10 Procedures Act (chapter 183), Oregon Revised Statutes. Licensee fully and finally waives the
11 right to a contested case hearing and any appeal therefrom by the signing of and entry of this
12 Order in the Board's records. Licensee neither admits nor denies, but the Board finds that
13 Licensee's conduct as described in the February 25, 2021, Amended Complaint and Notice of
14 Proposed Disciplinary Action violated ORS 677.190(1)(a), as defined in ORS 677.188(4)(a) and
15 (b); ORS 677.190(8); ORS 677.190(13); ORS 677.190(17); and ORS 677.190(26). Licensee
16 understands that this Order is a public record and is a disciplinary action that is reportable to the
17 National Practitioner Data Bank and the Federation of State Medical Boards. Licensee
18 understands the terms of this Order and signs freely, without fraud or duress.

20 Licensee and the Board agree that the Board will close this investigation and resolve this
21 matter by entry of this Stipulated Order, subject to the following conditions:

22 4.1 Licensee agrees to limit his orthopedics practice to an office-based, outpatient,
23 non-surgical practice only.

24 4.2 The Stipulated Order of January 7, 2016, terminates effective the date the Board
25 Chair signs this Stipulated Order.

26 4.3 Licensee must obey all federal and Oregon state laws and regulations pertaining
27 to the practice of medicine.
