The Oregon Medical Board (Board) is the state agency responsible for licensing, regulating and disciplining certain health care providers, including physicians, in the State of Oregon. Brenda Diane Roberts, MD (Licensee) is a licensed physician in the State of Oregon.

2.

On April 13, 2017, the Board opened an investigation after receiving credible information regarding Licensee's possible violation of the Medical Practice Act. On July 10, 2017, Licensee entered into an Interim Stipulated Order with the Board in which she agreed to practice only in clinical settings pre-approved by the Board. On September 5, 2017, Licensee entered into a second Interim Stipulated Order in which she agreed to withdraw from practice pending the completion of the Board's investigation.

3.

Licensee and the Board desire to settle this matter by the entry of this Stipulated Order. Licensee understands that she has the right to a contested case hearing under the Administrative Procedures Act (Oregon Revised Statutes chapter 183), and fully and finally waives the right to a contested case hearing and any appeal therefrom by the signing of and entry of this Order in the Board's records. Licensee neither admits nor denies, but the Board finds that Licensee engaged in conduct that violated the Medical Practice Act, to wit: ORS 677.190(1)(a), unprofessional or dishonorable conduct, as defined in ORS 677.188(4)(a); ORS 677.190(13) gross negligence or repeated negligence in the practice of medicine; and ORS 677.190(23) violation of the federal

1 Controlled Substances Act. Licensee understands that this Order is a public record and is a
2 disciplinary action that is reportable to the DataBank and the Federation of State Medical
3 Boards.

5 Licensee and the Board agree that the Board will close this investigation and resolve this
6 matter by entry of this Stipulated Order, subject to the following conditions:

7 4.1 Licensee surrenders her Oregon medical license while under investigation.

8 4.2 The Interim Stipulated Orders of July 10, 2017, and September 5, 2017, terminate
9 effective the date this Stipulated Order is signed by the Board Chair.

10 4.3 Licensee must obey all Federal and Oregon State laws and regulations pertaining
11 to the practice of medicine.

12 4.4 Licensee stipulates and agrees that any violation of the terms of this Order shall
13 be grounds for further disciplinary action under ORS 677.190(17).

15 This Order becomes effective the date it is signed by the Board Chair.
